1- Plain song

Folk-song + tenors.

a. Jewish Synagogue = Yizdal, #17.

b. Greeks =

a. Yizdal = generally considered as of ancient Hebrew origin.

2- Neu Emmanuel.

Melody of 13th century.

The Catholic church music is founded on the plain-song.

2- The Choral. - or Hymn Tunes,

begin with the Reformation,

Born in London, Feb. 21. 1801.

Father was a banker.

Trinity College, Oxford, 1820.

Fellow at Christ College, 1827.

Incumbent at St. Mary's Oxford, 1828.

Went to Sicily, at Leonforte.
Malarial fever.

On his way home, "in an orange boat,
while the boat was becalmed, he
wrote his famous hymn. Leach, Kindly
Light.

Its original title, "The Pillar of
the Cloud,"

Published in 1836.

June 16, 1833

Oxford movement started.

In 42 - he presided over a woman's
movement, which he had organized
at Littlewood.

In 1845, he entered the Catholic
church.

In 1854 - Rector of the ^{Roman} New Catholic
University at Dublin.

Diplomatic & Literary Career.

1835 - Elected to House of Commons
as a Radical from Kidwanch.

Never voted against the whigs
except when the whigs voted
with the Tories,

Brilliant Diplomatic Career,
in the Orient.
